Every year the Michigan Association of Osteopathic Family Physicians (MAOFP) recognizes and bestows an award for the outstanding scientific paper written by an Osteopathic Family Practice resident in a Michigan training program. As part of the requirements of an ACOFP approved residency program, each FP resident must complete a scientific paper. MAOFP requests submission of all scientific papers from FP residents in training for review and consideration for the "MAOFP Family Practice Resident Scientific Paper of the Year Award." Previous publication of the paper is acceptable. More than one paper may be submitted for consideration, but only a single prize can be awarded in a calendar year. MAOFP offers family practice residents an opportunity to gain recognition and a monetary award for their scholarly activity.

The winners will be invited to attend our annual MAOFP Summer Family Medicine Update. The winners will be announced and receive their award at the Stakeholder's Membership Meeting which takes place in conjunction with the conference.
