

The Michigan Association of Osteopathic Family Physicians (MAOFP) requests nominations annually for our prestigious award that recognizes the outstanding MSUCOM Student Physician of the Year, a graduating student who has demonstrated exceptional commitment to osteopathic family medicine during medical school. Nominees for this award should be graduating in 2022, a member in good standing of MAOFP and exemplify the highest qualities of dedication to the osteopathic profes-sion, to patients, and to the community through professional and public service as a student. Schol-arship and leadership activities will also be recognized.

The award recipient will be recognized at the MSUCOM Awards Ceremony. The award recipient will receive a monetary award of \$250 and a certificate of recognition. The criteria for this award will be based upon the nominee's strengths in the following areas:

- Scholarship achievement
 (e.g. good academic standing; participating in research/scholarly activity; etc.)
- 2. Leadership qualities and community involvement during educational training (tutoring/mentoring; volunteering for organizational and community projects, etc.)
- Dedication to the osteopathic profession
 (e.g. involvement in political action/committees, etc.)
- 4. Dedication to osteopathic family medicine (e.g. ACOFP Student chapter leadership role; MAOFP leadership role)

Candidates for the MAOFP MSUCOM Student of the Year Award may be nominated by any of the following: Family Medicine Department Chairperson, preceptor; faculty member, mentor; DME or hospital administrator, physician, resident, intern, or another student.

Each candidate must submit a one-page biography, as well as a written statement(s) from each nominating person. The student may have more than one nominating individual. This information can be filled out using the attached form. A curriculum vitae must be attached as a separate document.

A letter from the Associate Dean from Student Life supporting the nomination and attesting to the student's good academic standing is also required. This letter should be provided as a separate document.
